**Project Title:** Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 04-1180 with City of Big Bear Lake Department of Water and Power.

**Project Location:** The Project is located at the Sheephorn Well site, southeast of the intersection of Moonridge Road and Sheephorn Road, within the City of Big Bear Lake (APN 0310-392-20).

**Project Description:** The San Bernardino County Flood Control District is proposing the renewal of existing Revenue License Agreement No. 04-1180 with City of Big Bear Lake Department of Water and Power. Amendment No. 2 extends the term of the current License for ten years, for the period from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2035, for non-exclusive access to Sheephorn Well (APN 0310-392-20).

Additionally, because this action is purely administrative and transactional in nature, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore it also qualifies for a commonsense exemption under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
