Reasons why project is exempt: The proposed upgrades and reactivations of existing stream gauges qualify for an exemption under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 - Existing Facilities, as it involves the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, or topographical features, with no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of approval. Additionally, because all work will occur from existing access roads, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility the activity may result in a significant effect on the environment. Therefore, the project also qualifies for the commonsense exemption under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
