These amendments are intended to align local regulations with recent state laws including, but not limited to, Senate Bill (SB) 234, Assembly Bill (AB) 101, 2162, AB 139, AB 2345 and AB 671, and to implement the 2021-2029 6th Cycle Housing Element.

Staff has determined that Ordinance No. 2 is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15282(h) which creates a statutory exemption for the adoption of an ordinance regarding second units in a single-family or multifamily residential zone by a city to implement the provisions of Article 2 (commencing with Section 66314) or Article 3 (commencing with Section 66333) of Chapter 13 of Division 1 of Title 7 of the Government Code as set forth in Section 21080.17 of the Public Resources Code. In addition, Ordinance No. 2 is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that amendments to the City's ADU and JADU regulations in accordance with State Law will have a significant effect on the environment.
