It increases the fine for using illegal fireworks and makes the enforcement process stronger and clearer for staff and public. The changes also allow the City to test a new enforcement program using video evidence to identify violations. These updates are meant to help reduce illegal fireworks activity, protect people and property, and make it easier for the City to hold the right parties accountable, especially during busy holidays like the Fourth of July. Residents benefit from a safer and more peaceful community.
