Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The City of Highland is adopting an updated Fire Hazard Severity Zone map, which comes from the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection. This update is required under Government Code Section 51175–51189, which lays out now cities must recognize and respond to fire risks in very high fire hazard areas. It helps the City make more informed decisions about development, emergency planning, and building safety. It also helps property owners better understand wildfire risks tied to their location so they can take steps to protect their homes.

Section 15061(b)(3)) of the CEQA Guidelines, which is the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment, and CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment. This Ordinance involves the adoption of an Ordinance designating the Fire Hazard Severity Zones Map as recommended by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection pursuant to Government Code Section 51178. There is no possibility that the Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment since the action is merely the adoption of a Fire Hazard Severity Zones Map as required by Government Code Section 51179. It can be seen with certainty that the adoption of an Ordinance will have no significant negative effect on the environment.
